There is an additional event on June 23 <sup>rd</sup> 7am to 11.45am at Meadlands social club, Needham Road, Stowmarket, when loose compost will be given out. Residents to bring their own shovels, plus up to two bags per car, and can help themselves on a first come, first served basis. A programme of service improvements is already underway, including a better system for booking appointments with the service team. We are also reorganising the work teams responsible for council house maintenance, including putting more work out to external contractors so that we can catch up with the backlog of repairs.&lt;/td&gt;&lt;/tr&gt;&lt;tr&gt;&lt;td&gt;Housing&lt;/td&gt;&lt;td&gt;The Council was successful in gaining an £800k grant for decarbonising our council housing stock. This will assist ongoing work such as improving insulation and replacing oil and older gas boilers with air source heat pumps. The Housing Solutions team has been shortlisted as Team of the Year in the Housing Heroes awards, for their work in supporting people out of homelessness/in need of emergency housing.&lt;/td&gt;&lt;/tr&gt;&lt;tr&gt;&lt;td&gt;Annual council&lt;br&gt;meeting&lt;br&gt;Weds 22&lt;sup&gt;nd&lt;/sup&gt; May&lt;/td&gt;&lt;td&gt;Our annual council meeting will take place on the 22&lt;sup&gt;nd&lt;/sup&gt; of May where we will vote in a new chair and vice-chair of the council, as well as chairs, vice-chairs and placings of all the council committees. Following directly on from this will be an ordinary council meeting where we will be debating a review of the boundary between Stowmarket and Onehouse parishes.&lt;/td&gt;&lt;/tr&gt;&lt;tr&gt;&lt;td&gt;Community&lt;br&gt;transport grants&lt;/td&gt;&lt;td&gt;Following a tender process, MSDC cabinet has approved £600,000 of funding for two community transport operators, to enhance public transport across the district.
