Bacton Parish Council Grants to Outside Organisations/Individuals – Policy

(Reviewed and adopted 2024 Mar 11-8 Governance)

GENERAL

(1) This policy is designed to help and guide local clubs, societies and organisations making applications for Grant Aid to Bacton Parish Council.

(2) It is a prime objective of the council to encourage local groups and this can be done through many ways, including Grant Aid.

(3) Grant Aid will be considered to help towards --

- (a) Capital cost of new or improved facilities or equipment
- (b) Providing a public service
- (c) Supporting a specific event
- (d) Improving the Environment
- (e) Enhancing Quality of Life

(4) Grants are awarded twice a year in June and November. The deadlines for applications are 15 June 2025, 15 October 2025 and then 15 May and 15 October respectively.

(5) Grant applications will be considered at ordinary meetings of the full Council. Each application will be assessed on its own merits and will be considered along with other applications at the meeting. To ensure as fair a distribution as possible, the Council will take into account the amount and frequency of previous awards.

CONDITIONS OF FUNDING

(6) Applications must be made on the attached form.

(7) The Parish Council will only give to activities specifically designed to benefit Bacton and its residents.

- (8) Applications will be considered from individuals as well as organisations.
- (9) Applications WILL NOT be considered from:-
 - (a) Organisation intending to support any particular Party Political or to discriminate on the grounds of race or religion
 - (b) Profit or surplus making private businesses

(c) Local groups whose fund raising is sent to their central HQ for redistribution

(10) Ongoing commitments to fund future years will not be made. A fresh application will be required each year.

(11) The Council could request details of membership, location of the group, and age range of the members where appropriate. They also could need to know the nature and activity of the organisation and full details to which the Grant Aid will be applied.

(12) The offer of Grant will be publicised in some form by the Parish Council.

(13) Only one grant will be considered for an organisation during the year unless there are exceptional circumstances, and these are to be reported and approved by the Council.
